

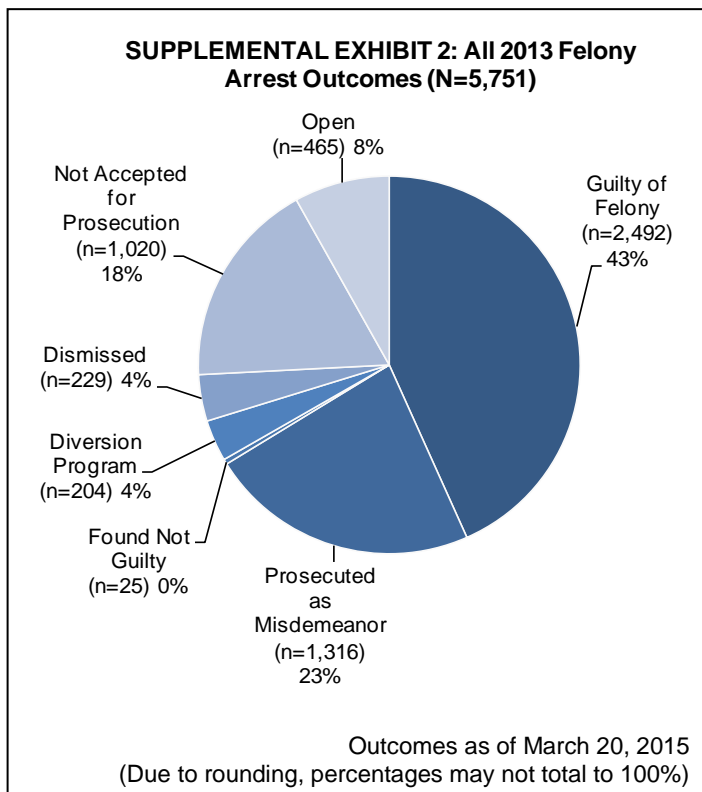
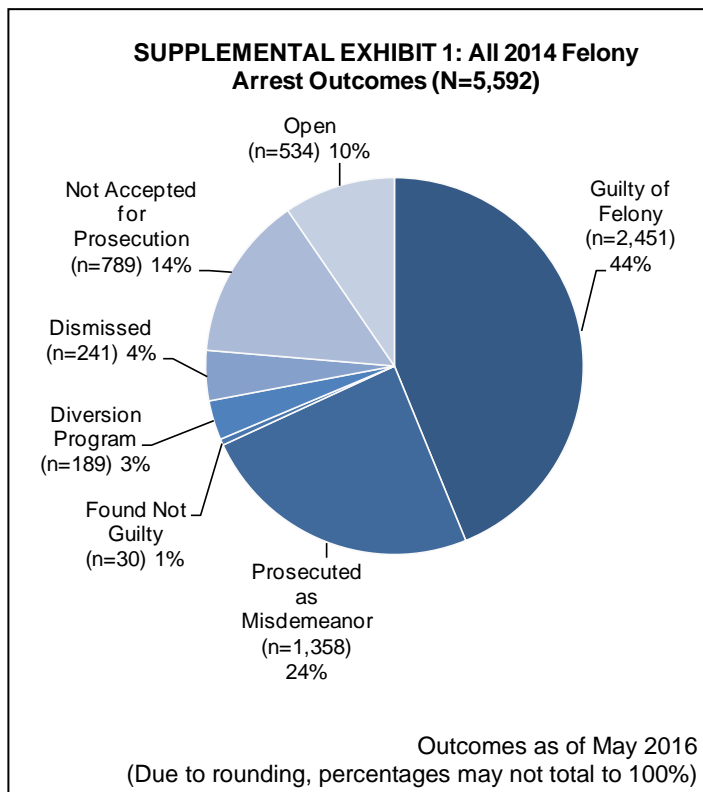

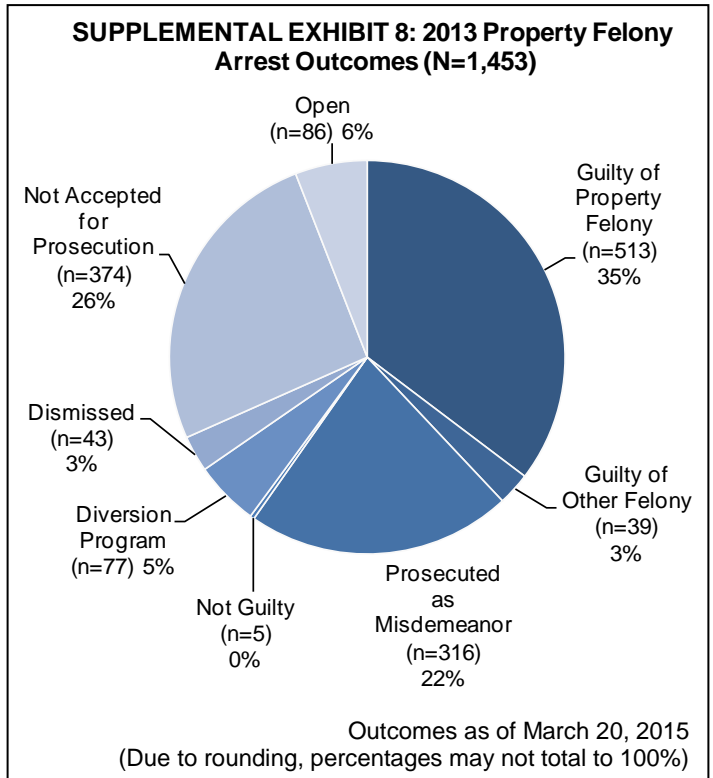
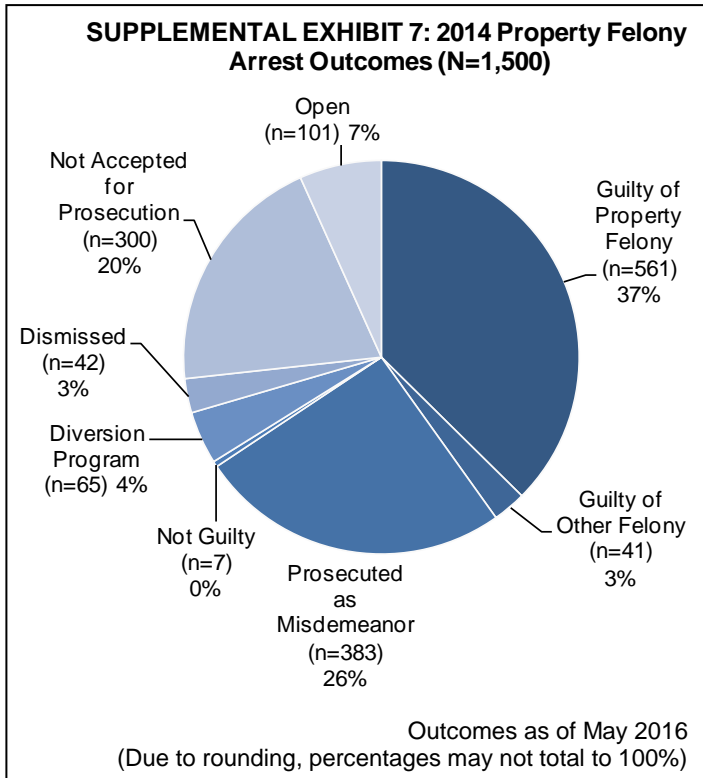

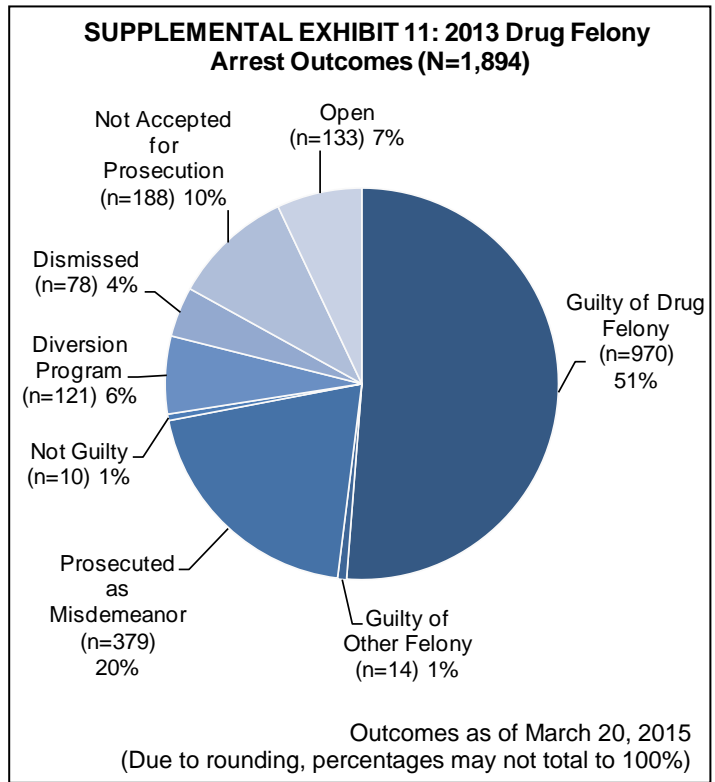
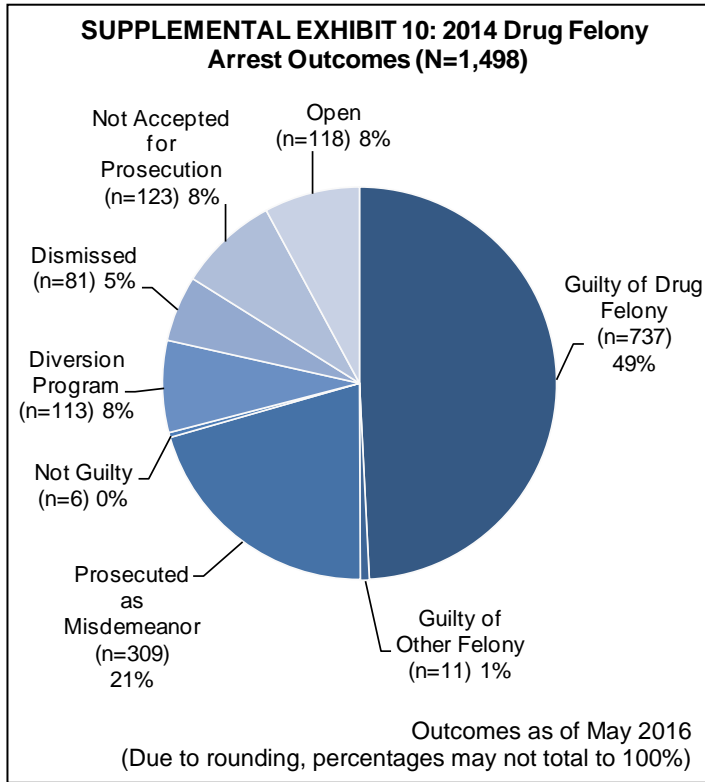

2014 DRUG FELONY ARREST OUTCOMES



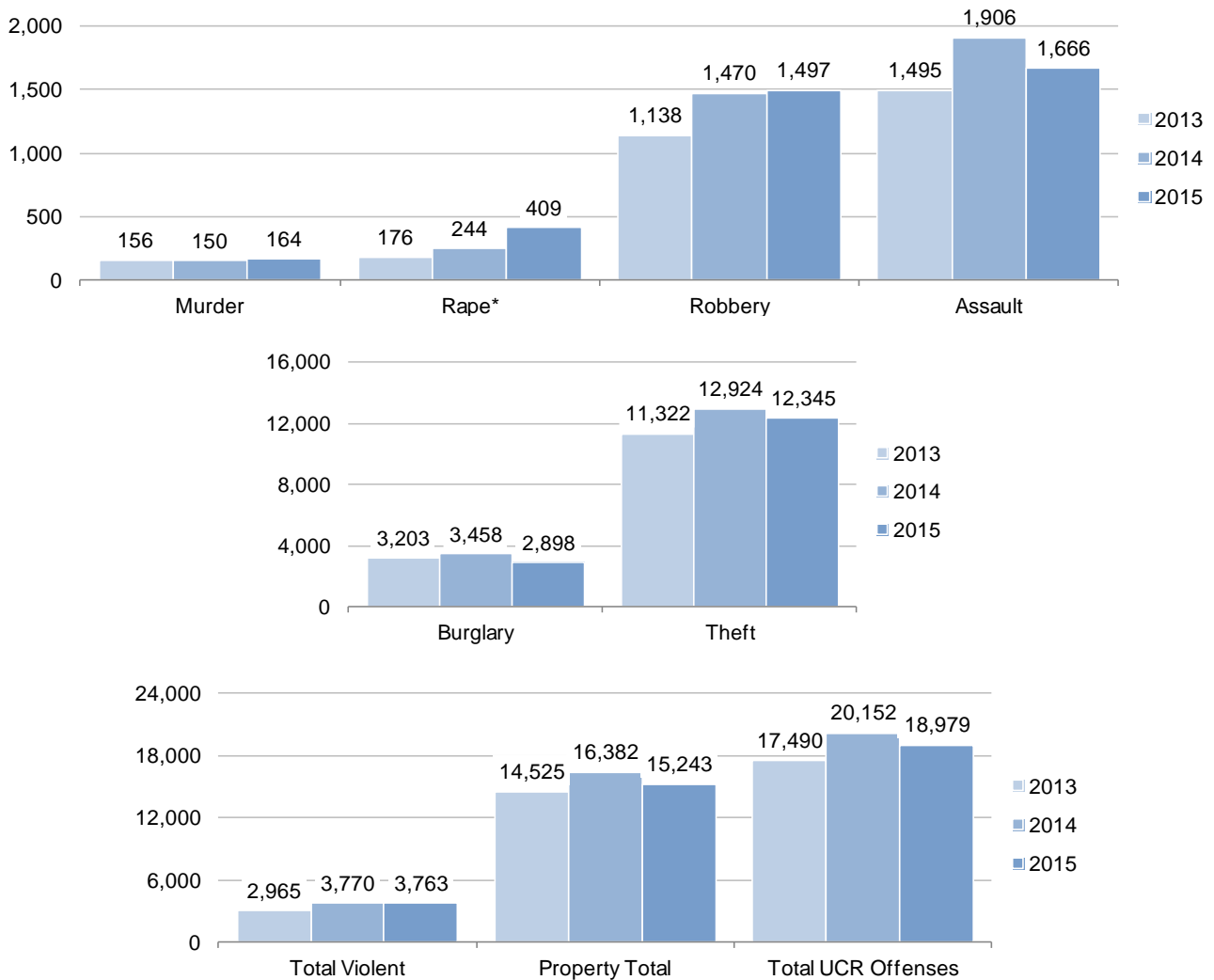

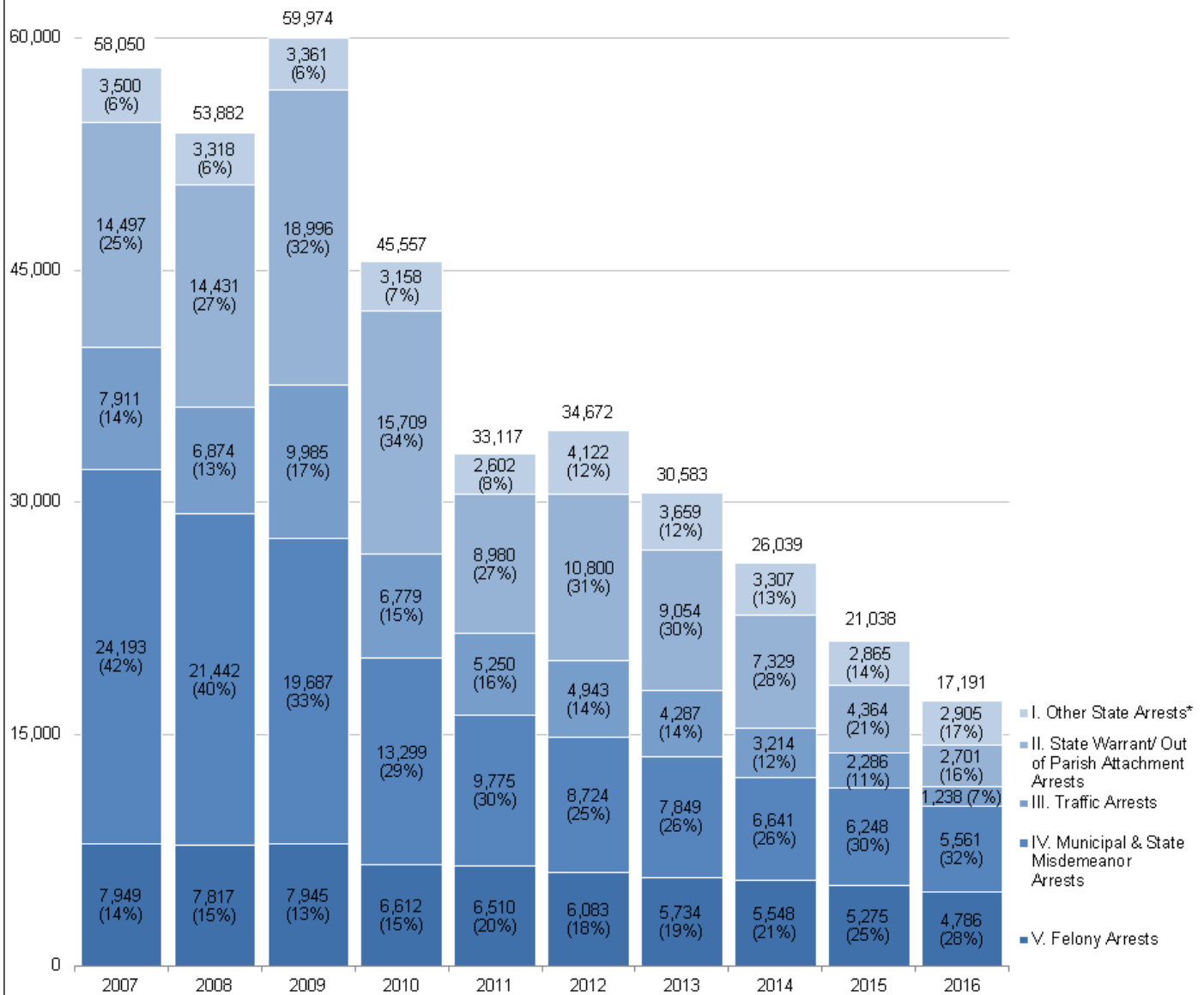
