

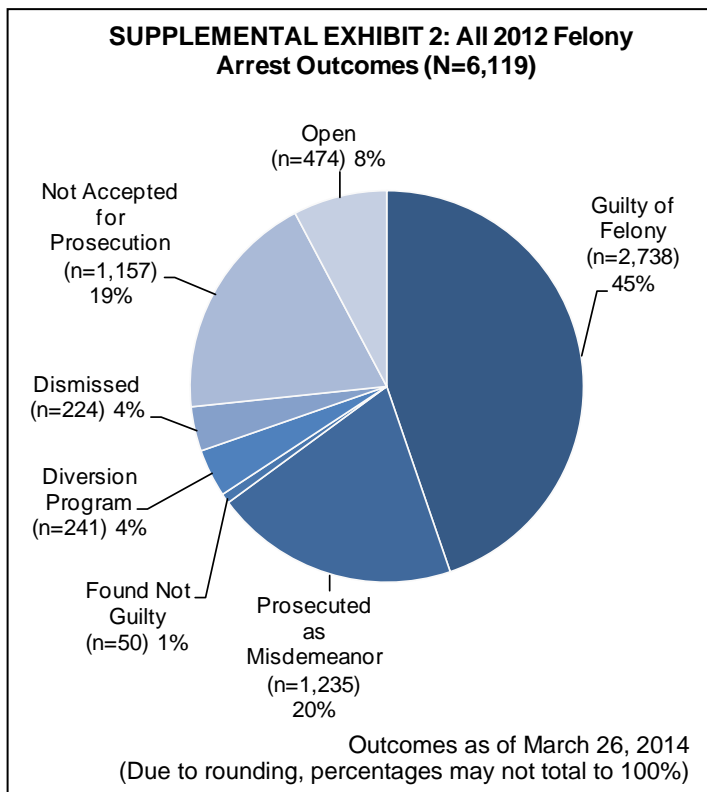
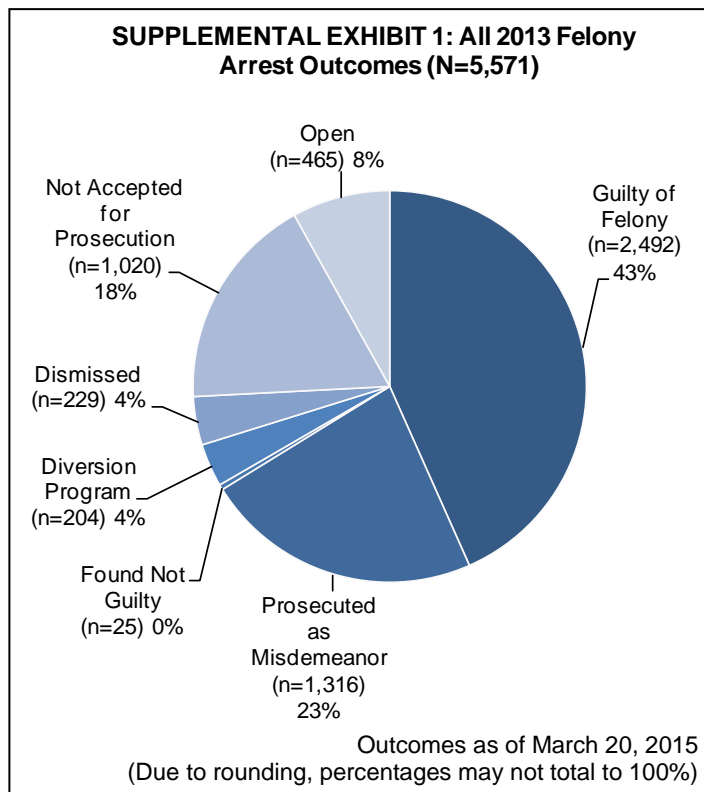

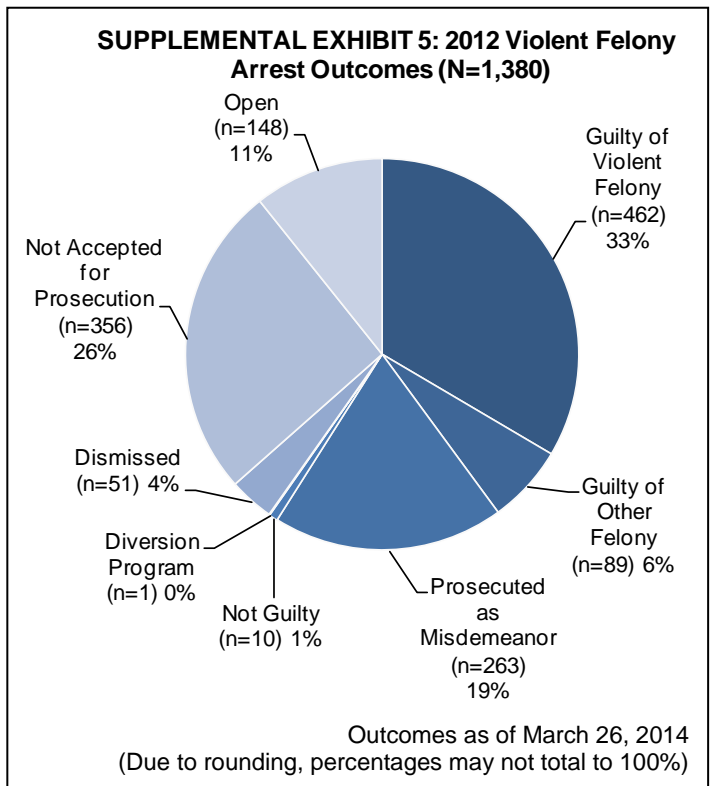

2013 VIOLENT FELONY ARREST OUTCOMES



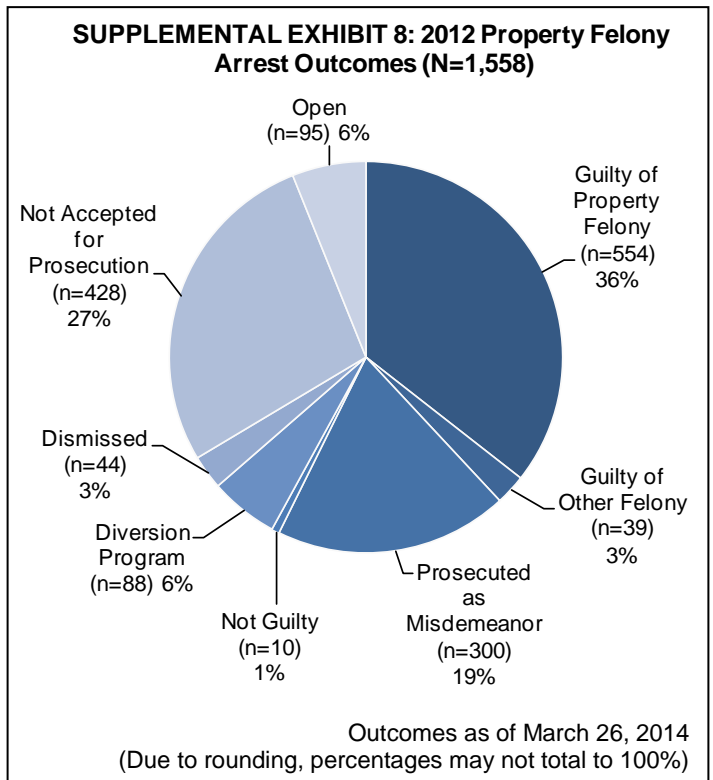
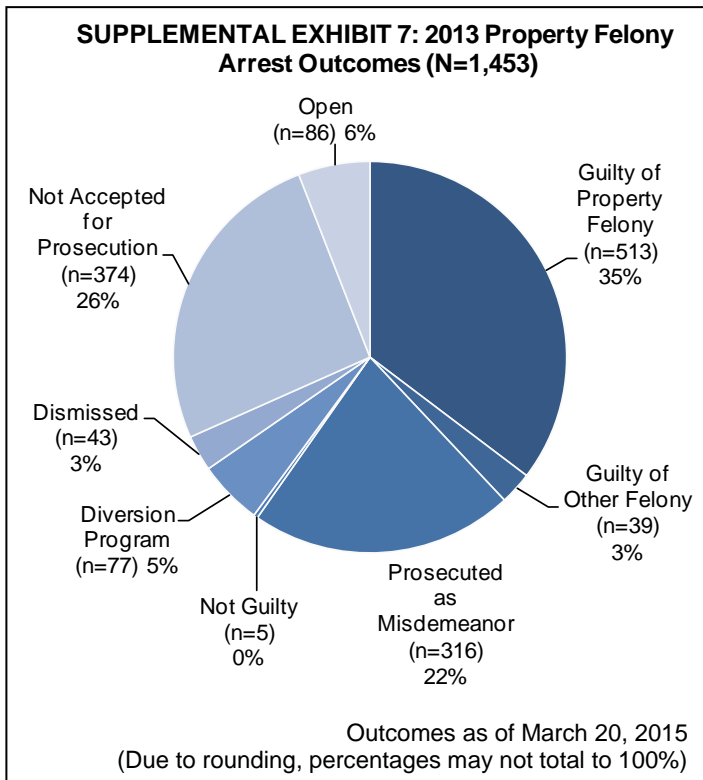

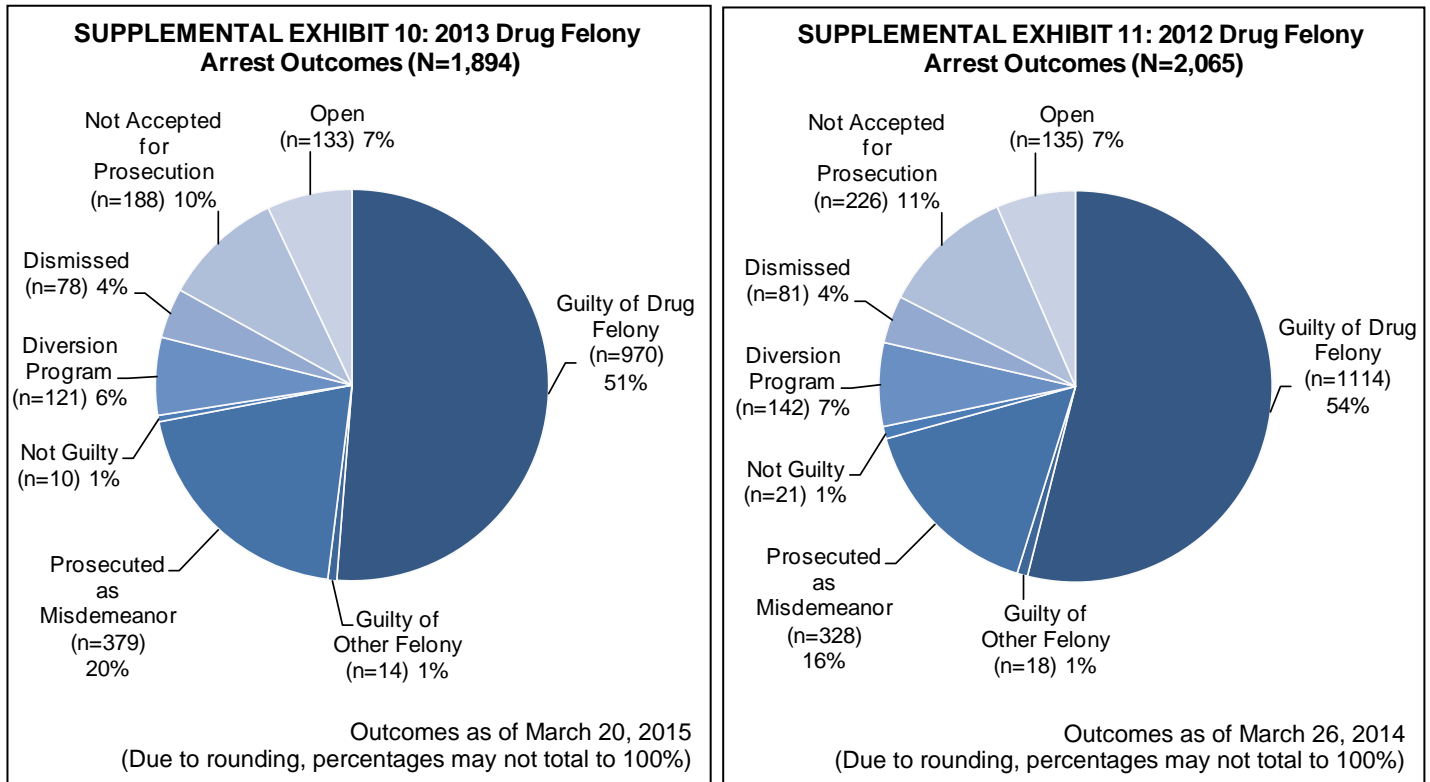

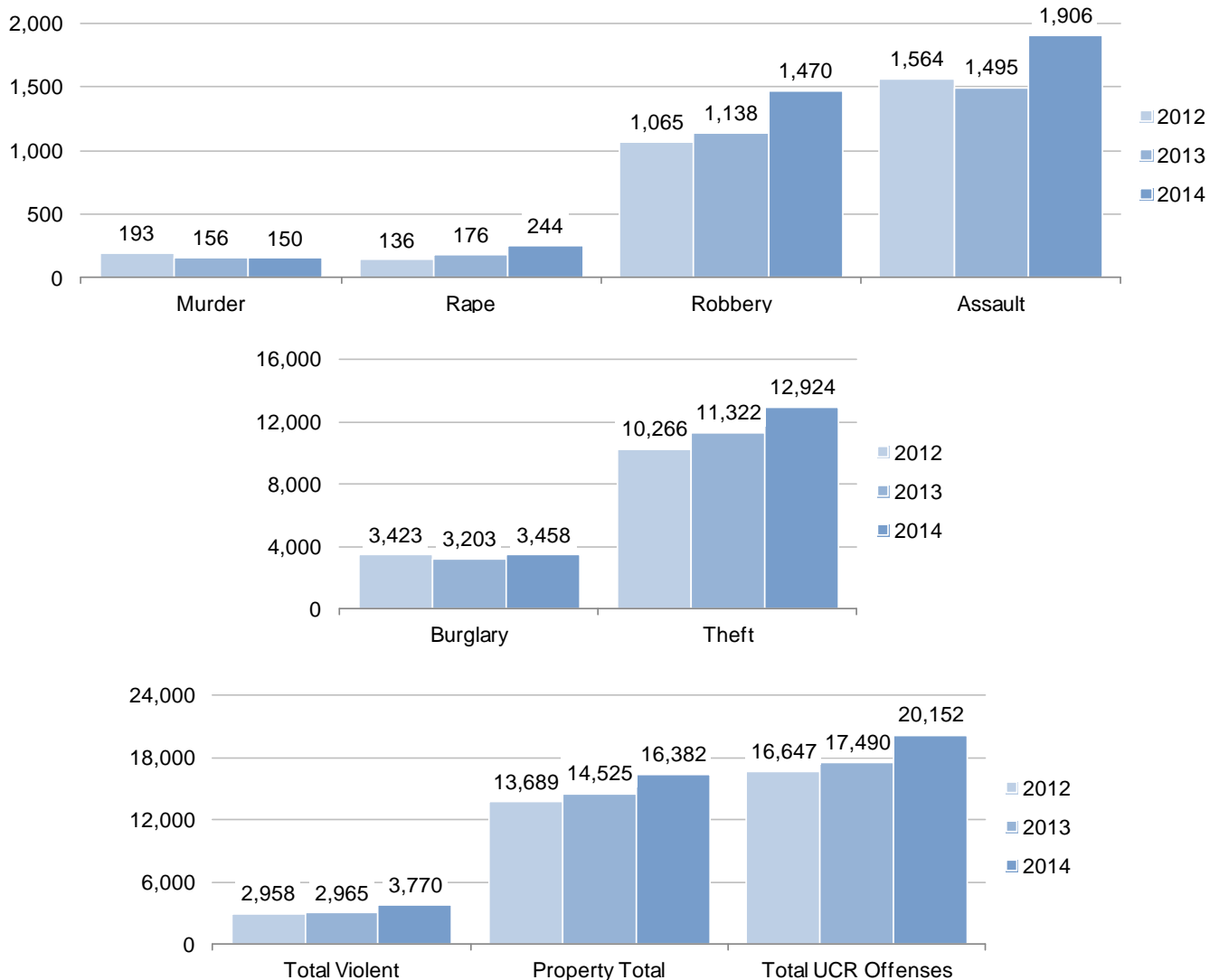

 Uniform Crime Report (UCR) Crimes 2012 – 2014**

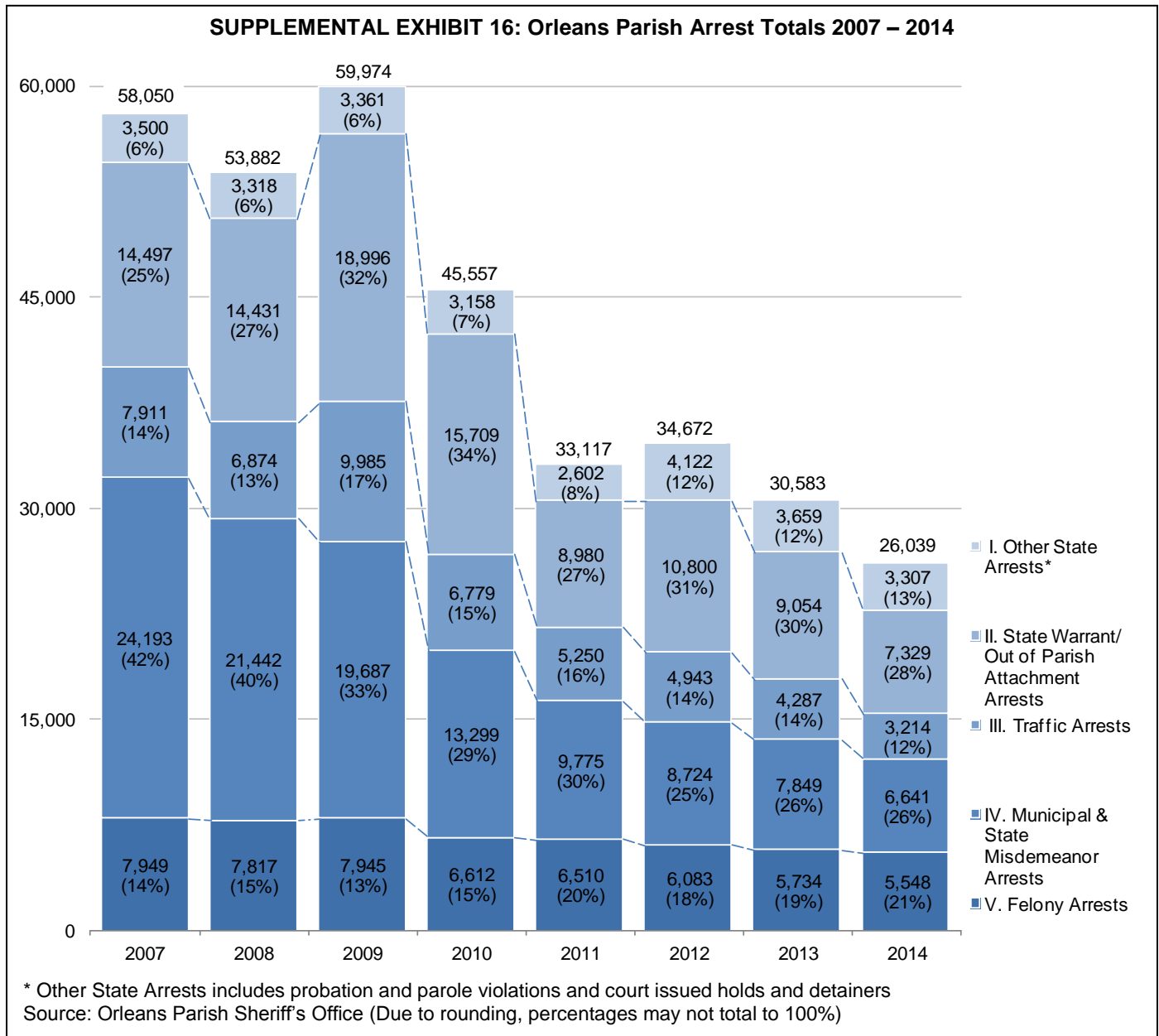


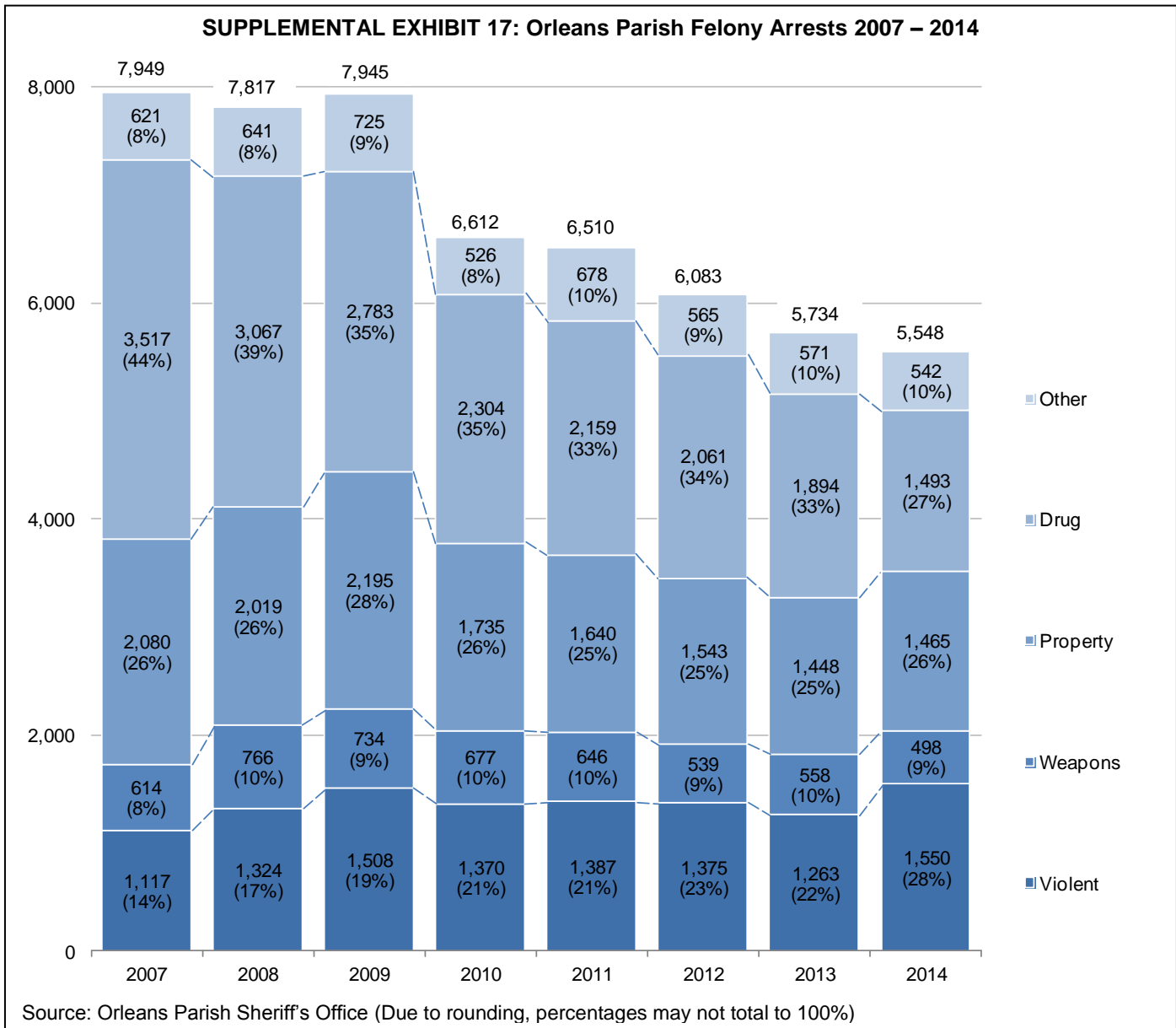
